Nominations Open for EBRI's 2013 Lillywhite Award

The nonpartisan Employee Benefit Research Institute (EBRI) has opened nominations for the 2013 Lillywhite Award, which acknowledges contributions by persons who have had distinguished careers in the investment management and employee benefits fields and whose outstanding service enhances Americans' economic security.

EBRI established the Lillywhite Award in 1992. Previous Lillywhite Award winners include Stanford University's William F. Sharpe, Jack Ehnes, CEO of the California State Teachers' Retirement System, and Don Ezra, formerly of Russell Investment Group.

The award was named after Ray Lillywhite, a pioneer in the pension field who for decades guided state employee pension plans, and who helped found numerous professional organizations and educational programs. He retired from Alliance Capital in 1992 at age 80 after a 55-year career in the pension and investment field. Lillywhite exemplified not only excellence but also innovation in lifelong achievements, teaching, and learning.

The award will be presented during the Pensions & Investments West Coast Defined Contribution Conference, October 27–29 in San Francisco.
