## 2013 Retirement Confidence Survey To Be Released Tuesday, March 19

On <u>Tuesday, March 19, 2013,</u> the nonpartisan Employee Benefit Research Institute (EBRI) and Mathew Greenwald & Associates, Inc., will release results of the <u>2013 Retirement Confidence Survey (RCS)</u>, the nation's longest-running and most comprehensive study of the attitudes and behavior of American workers and retirees toward all aspects of saving, retirement planning, and long-term financial security.

This is the 23rd annual RCS and will contain long-term trend data going back to earlier RCS results. Recent waves of the RCS have measured record-low levels of public confidence in the ability to afford retirement.
