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EBRI to Testify at April 17 Ways & Means Hearing On Tax Treatment of Retirement Plans

EBRI Research Director Jack VanDerhei will be one of the witnesses testifying Tuesday, April 17, at a hearing by the House Ways and Means Committee on the tax treatment of employment-based retirement plans, such as 401(k)s.

VanDerhei will report on new EBRI research quantifying the likely impact of recent proposals to change the current tax status of retirement plans by reducing current limits on contributions or replacing the current tax treatment of 401(k)s contributions with a tax credit.
