## 2018 Retirement Confidence Survey To Be Released Tuesday, April 24

On <u>Tuesday, April 24, 2018,</u> the nonpartisan Employee Benefit Research Institute (EBRI) and Greenwald & Associates, Inc., will release results of the <u>2018 Retirement Confidence Survey (RCS)</u>, the nation's longest-running and most comprehensive study of the attitudes and behavior of American workers and retirees toward many aspects of saving, retirement planning, and long-term financial security.

This is the 28th annual RCS. In 2018, for the first time, defined contribution (DC) plan participants were asked about their plans for the money accrued in their plan when they retired.
